Feedback from fete last year to take into account

Stalls – We would like to ask back the following stalls next year as they were lovely and sold really well – The toy lady, Sparrow Lady and Crystal/Resin ladies.

Next year £15 per table or two for £20. We will take the payment up front now that we have a paypal account and will be refundable up to two weeks before the fete. This is to avoid people cancelling at last minute.

Bar – Another bottle of pimms needed – 4L in total

More diet drinks - Double for next year

If the forecast is looking hot then bottles of water, as people were asking if we sold this

Coors cans flew out and cans sold out quicker then bottles

Old speckled hen – Just one box next time

Ice pops – Could have sold more if we had them ready to go. If we buy a second hand freezer for next year, we could also sell ice creams

BBQ – Need lots more onions – 8 bags next year

Burgers- 35 left, so buy 125 next year

Biscuits - Next year 1 less table and also change the location as it was tucked away this time

Chocolate Tombola – Next year ticket with a 0 or 5 on the end wins, which will make it a lot easier and put the chocolate in number order on the table. We had just the right amount of chocolate

Hoop a jar – Loads of jars, same needed next year, along with a 3^{rd} slot for someone to be on the stall

Sweets – Put on the bar next year

Extra game ideas – Hook a duck, splat a rat and welly wang

Dunking pool – Very hard to see who had paid

Stocks – Have a separate person to manage this as was very busy. Need fresh water regularly, keep on concreate and away from the grass

Bouncy castle/slide – Just about broke even, maybe we could ask TT pumps to sponser next year and they could have a sign next to it to advertise.

Teas and coffees – Be sure to put Simons mum and dad on the last slot for the day again next year as they wash and box everything after.

Shut the front gates 15 mins before opening, as people were arriving early and coming in free of charge
